Introduction

Thank you for your purchase of NX from DNP. Please read this guide before using the product.

Software License Agreement

This agreement("Agreement") sets forth the terms and conditions under which Dai Nippon Printing Co., Ltd. ("DNP") grants you a license to use the software and its series products defined below("Software"). You are deemed to have agreed to this Agreement when you have clicked the accept button of this Agreement on the display of your computer at the time of installation of the Software.

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- (1) This Agreement shall be agreed when you have clicked the accept button of this Agreement on the display of your computer at the time of installation of the Software and shall be effective until terminated by either of the causes below:
 - 1) You delete all the Software installed on your computer and cease the use of the Software;
 - 2) You are in breach of any term or condition of this Agreement.
- (2) Upon termination of this Agreement by your breach of any term or condition of this Agreement, you must immediately cease the use of the Software and delete all the Software installed on your computer and return all other Software to DNP.

(3) Notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement, Section 3, Section 4, Section 5(2) and (3), Section 6(3)(4) and (5), Section 7 and Section 8 shall survive and remain effective after such termination.

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7. Governing law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Japan. All controversies arising from the interpretation and performance of this Agreement shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tokyo District Court of Japan.

8. Severability

If any provision hereof is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or operation of any other provision and such invalid provision shall be deemed to be severed from this Agreement.

2. Connecting the Photo printer

Connect the photo printer you want to use and install the printer driver. Please follow the instruction attached on the printer to install the driver.

3. Installing the USB Dongle (USB License Key)

After you completed the installation, you need to install USB license Key driver to detect the key. This process allows you to use standard version of NX.

Windows Xp /Vista

Insert USB license key to USB port on your computer.

[Welcome to the Found New Hardware Wizard] appears. Then select [No, not this time] and press [Next >] button.



Select [Install from the list of specific location (Advanced)] and press [Next >] button.



Insert install disk into the optical drive.

Select [Search for the best driver in these locations] and check [Include this location in the search]. Press [browse] button and designate the location at the install disk as below. If optical drive is E , For 32 bit : E:\nx\driver\JSPUSB_driver\USB\32 For 64 bit : E:\nx\driver\JSPUSB_driver\USB\64

Then press [Next >] button.



Pandra.inf will be detected.

If you have already installed this driver before, oem13.inf will be also detected. Both will be OK to complete this installation. Then press [Next >].



[Insert Disk] window appears. Press [OK] button.



[Files Needed] window appears. Please designate the same location you do at previous process. For 32 bit : E:\nx\driver\JSPUSB_driver\USB\32 For 64 bit : E:\nx\driver\JSPUSB_driver\USB\64 If you select the oem13.inf at the previous steps, this step will be skipped. Press [OK] button.



[Completing the Found New Hardware Wizard] appears. The driver installed successfully. Press [Finish] button to complete the installation.



Windows 7

Insert USB license key to USB port on your computer. Driver Installation will start.



Installation will fail.



Press Start button and right click on [Computer]. Then select [Manage] from the list.



Computer Management window comes up. Click and open [Device Manager].



You will find [Unknown Device] or [HardKey] on the list.



Double click on [Unknown Device] or [HardKey]. Properties window come up.

If you are using Windows Vista or Windows 7 on your computer, you have to turn off the User Account Control following the instruction below.

Windows Vista Preparation

Open the Control panel from the start menu. Then select [User Account and Family Security].



Select [User Accounts].



Select [Turn User Account Control on or off].



[User Account Control] window appears and says [Windows needs your permission to continue]. Press [Continue] button. Uncheck the [Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer] option. Then press [OK] button.



Press [Restart Now] to apply this setting.

Installing the application

Insert the install disk into the optical drive on your computer and execute the setup file (Setup #### E.exe, where #### is a 4 digit number).

Setup files exist at the location below in the install disk.
